

The 2024 NU Thai Cultural Exchange Student Program

Naresuan University (NU), Thailand, cordially invites international undergraduate students to participate in the **2024 NU Thai Cultural Exchange Program**. This 14-day program will offer a variety of activities that will introduce participants to various aspects of Thai culture.

Activities: Thai Music, Thai Dance, Thai Cooking, Thai Boxing, Thai Massage, Get to Know Thailand: Thai Culture, Get to Know Thailand: Thai Language, Dress Like Thais, Traditional Hanging Decoration & Bag Patterning, Internationalization at Home, Activities with NU Students, Cultural Visits and Excursions

Venue: Naresuan University, Phitsanulok, Thailand

Program Period: 25 August – 7 September 2024

Number of Students: 20 undergraduate students from Japan

Program Fee: 450 USD (Japanese partnered universities), 900 USD (Non-partnered universities)

Program fee includes: Cultural Visits & Excursions (Phitsanulok & Sukhothai), Accommodation (NU Dormitory – 2 People/Room), Airport Transfer (Bangkok - Phitsanulok - Bangkok), Local Transport, Meals, Welcome Lunch and Farewell Dinner, Teaching Materials, On-campus Wi-Fi, Souvenir, Certificate of Attendance, and Thai Buddies (Naresuan University students)

Costs covered by participants: International Flight to Bangkok, Overseas Travel Insurance, and Personal Expenses

Eligibility: Applicants must meet the following requirements

- a bachelor's degree student
- enrolled as a full-time student at his/her home university during the exchange period
- able to communicate in English
- interested in learning Thai culture
- excellent in interpersonal skills

Required Application Documents:

1. NU Application Form which can be downloaded at <https://url.in.th/fguYU>
2. A Nomination Letter from your university's International Office or Dean, endorsing all applying students for the participation in this exchange program.
3. A copy of a passport which is valid for at least 6 months prior to the program commencement
4. A Full Coverage Overseas Travel Insurance

Deadline for Nomination and Application: August 2, 2024 (ICT - Indochina Time)

The nomination letter and application documents must be submitted to the International Office of your university and should be emailed to us by the International Office. Please send the "nomination letter" to us at nusae@nu.ac.th by Friday, **August 2, 2024**. We do not have the designated form of an official nomination letter. However, it should be printed on the letter head, which includes name, gender, date of birth, nationality, area of specialization, and name of faculty/school.

Payment of the program fee:

After the nomination and application deadline closes, applicants granted permission for admission will be notified of the deadline for program fee payment. Program fees that have already been paid are non-refundable unless there are insufficient number of applicants to cover the breakeven of the program. Please note that transfer fee is the applicant's responsibility, except the transfer fee for refund, which will be taken care of by the university in case of insufficient number of applicants to launch the program.

Important Remark:

The program is subject to change. If there are insufficient number of participants, a full refund will be made individually to each applicant who has already remitted the program fee.
