- POSITION: Tenure-track Associate Professor, or Tenure-track Assistant Professor
 ※Affiliation: The Institute for Frontier Science Initiative and the Cancer Research Institute, Kanazawa University(Unit Leader/Chief: Dr. Kazuo Okamoto)
 - * Role: Principal Investigator (PI) who are assigned as Associate Professor or Assistant Professor of this open position is obliged to vigorously promote inter-, cross-, and multi-disciplinary researches. Additionally, selected PI is obliged to fulfill the duty as faculty members at the Cancer Research Institute of Kanazawa University (see for details in 【3. Research area】).

- 2. Compensation : Annual salary system is applied.

3. RESEARCH AREA:

Our major research interest is to elucidate the molecular mechanisms of cancer, cancer stem cells and tumor microenvironment, aiming at developing novel diagnostic and therapeutic strategies for precision medicine. We have been developing breast cancer patient-derived xenograft (PDX) models, 3D organoid/spheroid cultures and mouse models of tumors. In order to achieve the goal, we are recruiting a scientist who has expertise in molecular biology, cell biology and bioinformatics, and has ability to translate the basic principle to clinic.
