## VISA



### Visit the K-ETA Website

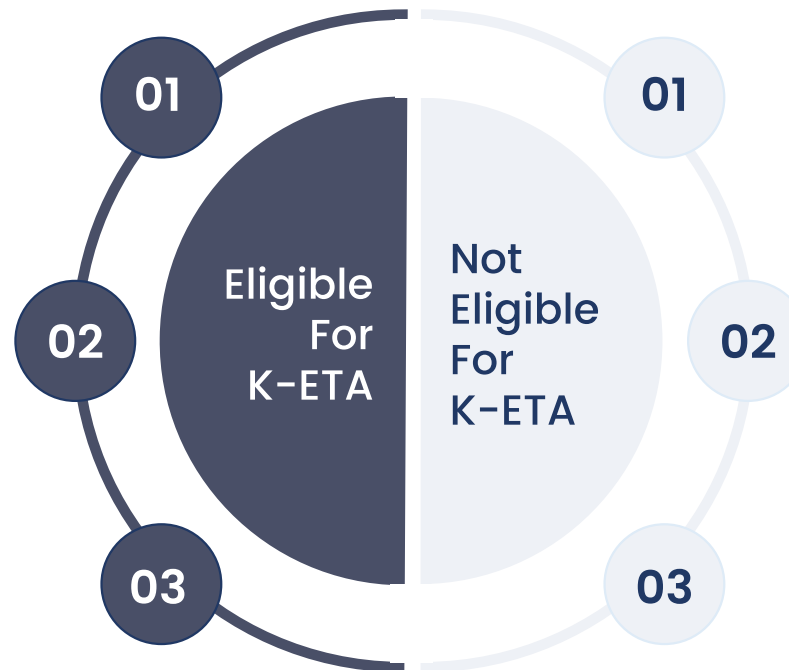
Go to the [K-ETA website](#) and look for your eligibility.

### Apply for K-ETA Online

Travelers are required to acquire the K-ETA at least 48 hours prior to your boarding.

### Get Ready for Departure

If you received your K-ETA, then everything is set to go!



### Consult Korean Embassy

Ask for the list documents required for the VISA application.

### Request documents from HYU

- Letter of Admission
- Invitation Letter
- Certificate of Business Registration

### Apply for a C-3-1/C-3-9 Visa

Visit the Korean Embassy in the country you are currently studying at to apply for the proper visa.

### Apply for a D-2-8 Student Visa

If you wish stay longer than your approved period of stay.

Submit the below documents by post at least 6 weeks prior to the first day of the program.

- **Certificate of Enrollment**
  - Verified through Apostille certification or Consular authentication from the Embassy of Korea
- **High School Graduation Certificate**
  - Verified through Apostille certification or Consular authentication from the Embassy of Korea
- **Financial Affidavit**
