





What HIWS(B) provides


Hanyang International Winter School Session B (HIWS B) is a packaged Edutainment program including every element international students would expect.

Visit the K-ETA Website

Go to the <u>K-ETA website</u> and look for your eligibility.

Apply for K-ETA Online

Travelers are required to acquire the K-ETA at least 48 hours prior to your boarding.

Consult Korean Embassy

Ask for the list documents required for the VISA application.

Request documents from HYU

- Letter of Admission
- Invitation Letter
- Certificate of Business Registration

Apply for a C-3-1/C-3-9 Visa

Visit the Korean Embassy in the country you are currently studying at to apply for the proper visa.

Apply for a D-2-8 Student Visa

If you wish stay longer than your approved period of stay.

Submit the below documents by post at least 6 weeks prior to the first day of the program.

- Certificate of Enrollment
 - Verified through Apostille certification or Consular authentication from the Embassy of Korea
- High School Graduation Certificate
 - Verified through Apostille certification or Consular authentication from the Embassy of Korea
- Financial Affidavit
