In particular, the institute focuses on " understanding of the mechanisms of basic cellular functions," "interdisciplinary research with innovative technology," and "clinical data science", with the goals of (1) discovering new principles of life, (2) understanding the nature of cancer and (3) developing diagnostic and therapeutic methods for cancer. Through such activities the candidate is expected to contribute to elucidate the mechanism of cancer and develop novel diagnostic and therapeutic methods. In addition, we are looking for candidates who are willing to take advantage of the fact that this research field is located on the Takara-machi Campus, where the Graduate School of Medical Sciences and the affiliated hospital are located, in an aim to build and develop a new research system closely related to clinical practice. Furthermore, you will be involved in pre-graduate and post-graduate professional education in the School of Medicine.
