Loneliness among elderly people is a major problem in Japan. According to Text (ii), elderly people report having fewer friends, and there are fewer elderly people than before who talk to other people every day. In addition, the number of elderly people living alone is increasing. I think one way this problem could be solved would be to encourage families to live with their grandparents. In the past, this was typical in Japan, but now it is less common.
